Green Week at Miller Park is June 20-26, so gear up to help reduce, reuse... and cycle to Miller Park during the "Bike to the Ballpark" event on Sunday, June 26. Before the Brewers vs. Twins game at 1:10pm, join the Friends of Hank Aaron State Trail, Menomonee Valley Partners and fellow cyclists for a ride along the Hank Aaron State Trail to Miller Park. Participants in this free\* event must register at one of two starting locations: the Harley-Davidson Museum® (6th and Canal Street, west parking lot) or the State Fair Park and Ride (76th Street) beginning at 10:00am on the morning of the ride. All participants must sign a waiver – available at either starting location – prior to participating in the ride. See instructions for registration, parking and ride route. The first 500 participants to finish the ride will receive a commemorative water bottle and a voucher for two free tickets to a future Brewers game.

- All participants must sign waiver at registration location and check in at Miller Park bike parking area to be eligible
- WEST registration and free automobile parking: 76th Street Park and Ride near State Fair, 10 a.m. - noon
- EAST registration and free automobile parking: 6th and Canal Street at Harley-Davidson Museum, 10 a.m. - noon
- CHECK IN at bike parking area. Owners are responsible for securing bikes to provided racks. 10:30 a.m. - game time.
- Distance is approximately 4 miles from each registration location
- Ride safely, obey traffic rules, helmets are recommended
- Bike ride held rain or shine
